The Menard County Public Building Study Group (PBSG) an advisory board appointed by the Menard County Board of Commissioners met at 6:30 PM on Wednesday, April 5, 2017 at the Menard County Courthouse located at 102 South Seventh Street, Petersburg. Steve Ozella called the meeting to order at 6:30 PM. Carl Fischer noted a correction to the March 1, 2017 minutes. Board Chair Robert Lott made a motion to approve the minutes from the March 1, 2017 meeting with the noted correction. Joe Hemberger seconded. Motion carried.

It was reported that Custom Structures has the Highway Department Sign Shop project on the schedule.

There was no update available on the Animal Control facility.

The third floor courthouse windows were discussed. Joe Hemberger presented a cost sheet prepared by the Marvin Windows representative. Upon further discussion, it was decided that Joe will provide a quote for the windows and installation, sashes only and painting of the exterior surface. PBSG Board consensus was that the county should place this on the next county board agenda for action.
